What are Persona Dolls?

- Persona Dolls are dolls made of fabric with more or less 70 cm.
- It's a 'friend' (with personality) that comes to visit the class.
- It's treated with care and respect, like we would treat a real person.
- Each doll has a unique personality, with a life story, like a real child.

How we use Persona Dolls?

- The doll visits the class when children are together and tells the children about her life or experience (happy or not so happy experiences).
- The doll talks with the teacher (whispers in her/his ear) and she/him tells the group what the doll has 'told' them.
- The goal is to capture the children's attention so they will be interested in what happens to the doll and will share information from their own lives.





Telling the story

- Plan a story with a simple issue.
- Remind them about the persona and the last visit.
- Be specific and use words that children can understand.
- Have a conversation about what happened to the doll and how s/he felt.
- It's a structured story session.
- Help children to develop and use vocabulary that express feelings
